

Referrals From Acute Care Facilities to Out of State RPTCs Second, Third, & Fourth Quarters 2007 & FY 2008 N = 322



Limited Bed Capacity can be defined in 2 ways:


A. Shortage of Existing Services



REASONS FOR READMISSION DENIALS GIVEN TO DISCHARGE PLANNERS FROM IN-STATE FACILITIES


