The Diversion Data Base is a record of demographic, clinical, and behavioral information about youth referred through the acute care pilot project to inpatient psychiatric facilities (psychiatric hospitals and residential psychiatric treatment centers). The data base assists the utilization review staff in performing the gate keeping function as identified in the Bring the Kids Home Initiative by providing data that identifies behavioral health treatment needs and gaps in service.







187 Secondary Reasons Out of 244 Referrals












# Acute Care Data Fiscal Years 2007 & 2008 Comparison

## Primary Reason for Acute Care Referral by Fiscal Year First Three Quarters FY07 & FY08




## Referral to Out of State Residential Psychiatric Treatment by Provider by Fiscal Year First Three Quarters of FY07 & FY08
