



Positive Behavior Supports Pilot: Integrated School-Community Project

School-Wide PBS Data Report




Pilot Sites' School-Wide PBS Data

This project currently works in 4 communities where at least one school has begun implementing School-Wide PBS, an instructional, preventative and data-driven approach to working with children regarding their behavior. The goal is to translate this approach in community agencies and within the community itself. Schools have been the starting point for this systems change approach and has already collected some initial outcome data showing PBS's effectiveness. The following data summarize data from Dillingham, Juneau and Sitka.



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Ketchikan is not included yet due to two significant differences between Ketchikan School District and the others. The primary difference is that the technical assistance to Ketchikan has been from the national TA provider, PBIS. The other communities are supported by Stone Soup Group and are reporting data to Stone Soup Group, one of the partners in the Pilot. This speaks to the larger issue of having a statewide Education PBS Leadership Team to serve the role of coordinating data collection and review.

Also, this school year, the grant source for school-wide PBS at Ketchikan is no longer available. The person who was coordinating school-wide PBS is no longer at the district. Due to this change, SW-PBS is handled more now by the individual schools rather than at the district level.
