

METHODS OF ASSURING TRANSPORTATION

I. Optional Medical Services

Alaska uses a transportation broker under the state plan brokerage authority at 440.170(a)(4) for air, and ferry transportation only and 440.170(a) authority for other transportation related expenses.

- A. Necessary medically related transportation services include transportation provided by ambulance, taxicab, ferry, or other common carrier.
- B. Transportation services include expenses for transportation determined to be necessary by the agency to secure medical examinations and treatment for a recipient [440.170(a)]
- C. Included under transportation services are the costs of necessary food and lodging for the recipient and, in accordance with § 440.170(a)(3), an escort to accompany the recipient.

II. Administrative Services

Administrative case management of transportation as a state plan function is performed and overseen by the state or other governmental entities.
