Re: Notice regarding animals, plants, and pesticide use in Alaska Pioneer Homes

Dear Pioneer Home resident/responsible party:

Assisted living home regulations mandate that we inform Pioneer Home residents regarding animals, poisonous plants, and pesticide use. (Please contact your home's Administrative Assistant if you wish to be placed on a list to receive prior notice of pesticide applications.)

Animals that may be present in an Alaska Pioneer Home are cats, dogs, guinea pigs, fish, and birds (including psittacine birds such as parrots, macaws, and parakeets).

A comprehensive list of poisonous plants that may be present inside or on the grounds of a Pioneer Home may be obtained by contacting (907) 465-4416. This list can also be found posted on the Division of Alaska Pioneer Homes' web site under General Resident and Family Information.
