RE: Notice regarding animals, plants and pesticide use

Dear Pioneer Home Resident or Responsible Party:

Assisted Living Home regulations mandate that we inform Pioneer Home residents regarding animals, poisonous plants, and pesticide use. Please contact your home's Administrative Assistant if you wish to be placed on a list to receive prior notice of pesticide applications.

Animals that may be present in a Pioneer Home are cats, dogs, guinea pigs, fish, and birds (including psittacine birds, such as parrots, macaws and parakeets)

A comprehensive list of poisonous plants that may be present inside or on the grounds of a Pioneer Home may be obtained by contacting (907) 465-4416. This list can also be found posted on the Division's web site under General Resident and Family Information.
