Functionality

- **HealtheHUB**

- Patient lookup, longitudinal record
- Demographics, visit data and Dx, labs, radiology reports, allergies, visit summaries
- “Traditional HIE”

- **ENS (Event Notification System)**

- Configurable based on ‘something happening’ – an ER admission, for example
- Panel can be created one by one, through spreadsheet upload, or dynamically

Additional Functionality

- Medication Fill History and PDMP (Prescription Drug Monitoring Program)
 - New functionality expected Dec/Jan
- Diagnostic Medical Imaging sharing
 - Available now, full integration in Q1 2019
- Lab Order Management/Order Entry
 - Q2 2019
- TigerConnect Secure Texting
 - Now!

Additional Functionality

- **Minimum Data Set Reporting** – timeline pending SoA activities
 - Final interface file standards expected soon
- **HIE Consent Management tool** (Q1 2019)
 - Critical for inclusion of behavioral health data in HIE!
- **Aurora (EMS) integration** (late 2019)
- **Single Sign On (SSO) and EHR based data display** (Q1 2019)

Timeline

- **October 2019** – Public Health Reporting live
- **November 2019** – Bulk of technology reimplementation done (like for like functionality)
- **December 2019**
 - API Connectivity
 - National Network connectivity (VA, CommonWell, Care Quality)
- **Feb 2019**
 - Single Sign On (SSO)
 - EHR Integration
 - Consent Tool

Timeline – When Should I Sign Up?

- Now, for a December/January onboarding for patient lookup and ENS (notifications) capability
- Now, for a February or March onboarding for contributing data
- Now, for being introduced to the onboarding queue for the MDS Reporting Database
