

## Provider Agreement for the provision of trauma-informed behavioral health services

A new Provider Agreement for the provision of trauma-informed behavioral health services to victims of domestic violence, sexual assault, and other forms of interpersonal violence has been posted online. This Agreement will pay for up to 10 trauma-informed behavioral health clinic services to individuals referred from a CDVSA Agency to a Behavioral Health Provider in which an MOA exists between the two organizations. In order to qualify for payment under this Agreement, both the CDVSA Agency and the Clinician rendering the behavioral health clinic services must have been trained in the DBH sponsored training "Trauma 101."
