Note: the unborn child of a pregnant woman counts in the household size for pregnant woman coverage. FPG = Federal Poverty Guidelines for Alaska

Key Points

- » Income information for all household members must be submitted with application.
- » Children with other health insurance may still be eligible.
- » Children, teens and pregnant women covered by Indian Health Services may be eligible.
