NOTICE OF CHANGES TO REGULATIONS 7 AAC 57 CHILD CARE FACILITIES LICENSING

The Child Care Program Office (CCPO) is happy to share the Department of Health & Social Services has adopted regulation changes in Title 7 AAC 57 of the Alaska Administrative Code (AAC) effective May 15, 2016, for Child Care Facilities Licensing.

The official written version of the revised regulations for 7 AAC 57 Child Care Facilities Licensing will be available on the CCPO website and on the state's on-line regulation website in July 2016.

The CCPO would like to thank licensed child care providers, partner agencies, CCPO staff, and all interested parties who provided comments and questions during the comment period which helped shaped these new regulations.

Information regarding changes to 7 AAC 57 Child Care Facilities Licensing will be provided during upcoming State of Alaska Licensing Provider Chats in June 2016. A schedule for these Provider Chats will be sent out once it is available. After the revised regulations are available, providers will have additional opportunities to receive information or ask questions during upcoming Provider Chats and/or by contacting their State of Alaska Child Care Licensing Specialist.
