

**AGGREGATE DATA REGARDING THE NUMBER OF DEATHS, INJURIES AND SUBSTANTIATED
ABUSE IN A CHILD CARE SETTING**

OCTOBER 1, 2014 - SEPTEMBER 30, 2015 (Federal Fiscal Year 2015)

1. Number of deaths in a child care setting:

None. This data is based on all provider types regulated in the State of Alaska: licensed Centers; licensed Group Homes; licensed Homes; Approved Non Relative Providers; Approved Relative Providers; and Parent's Achieving Self-Sufficiency (PASS) I & PASS II/III In-home Providers.

2. Number of serious injuries in a child care setting:

This data is based on all provider types regulated in the State of Alaska: licensed Centers; licensed Group Homes; licensed Homes; Approved Non Relative Providers; Approved Relative Providers; and PASS I & PASS II/III In-home Providers.

In Federal Fiscal Year 2015 (FFY15), out of an average total of 1,006 child care facilities with a total potential capacity of at least 17,395 children, there were 101 reported injuries statewide that required medical attention outside the child care facility. Of the total 101 reported injuries statewide, 31 (30.7%) injuries were defined as "serious injury".

3. Number of incidences of substantiated child abuse in a child care setting:

None. This data is based on all provider types regulated in the State of Alaska: licensed Centers; licensed Group Homes; licensed Homes; Approved Non Relative Providers; Approved Relative Providers; and PASS I & PASS II/III In-home Providers.
