The Infant Learning Program (ILP) has contacted the State WIC office regarding referrals for clients from birth to 3 years old, with hemoglobin levels of <9.0 gm/dl. They are requesting these children be referred into their program. Please, reference WIC Report 344: High-Risk Low Hemoglobin Participant List to facilitate the referral process.

Please refer these high risk infants and children meeting these criteria to ILP. ILP can create a developmental screening and learning plan to ensure these children are receiving the environmental support for a child's cognitive development in addition to nutritious WIC foods.
