New MOV Food Packages as Requested by LAs

Local agency staff requested new MOV food packages containing low fat milk combinations for Pregnant/BF Women, and dry/UHT milk combinations for children, so the following packages have been created:

P/BF Women MOV

9218 E2% / U2% / 2 LB Cheese/Beans Only
9219 D / U2% / 2 LB Cheese/ Beans Only

Child MOV

9144 D / U / 2 LB Cheese/PB or Beans
9145 D / U2% / 2 LB Cheese/Beans Only/Red-Juice

Disabled On-Site Food Packages

The following food packages have been disabled. They contained FIs that listed 10 qts dry milk, but powdered milk is not available at stores in a 10 qt size. Most food packages with dry milk now contain 12 qts, combined with other types of milk if necessary to provide the required total quantity. Most FIs containing 10 qt. of dry milk have now been disabled. **When you are creating custom food packages, please do not use FIs that contain 10 qts of dry milk.**
