Infant formulas- All brands of infant formulas are covered by a cost containment contract. The formulas below require documentation of medical need through an approved ENPR for issuance, and do not generate a rebate for the state.

- Enfamil AR Lipil powder
- Enfamil Gentlease Lipil powder
- Good Start soy powder
- Good Start Gentle powder

Exempt Infant Formulas are intended for infants who have inborn errors of metabolism, low birth weight, or who have other medical or dietary concerns

Medical Foods are certain enteral products specifically formulated to provide nutritional support for individuals with a diagnosed medical condition when the use of conventional foods is precluded, restricted, or inadequate. They may be nutritionally complete or incomplete. They must have the purpose of a food, provide a source of calories and one or more nutrients, and be designed for enteral digestion via oral or tube feeding.
