

PURCHASING MILK WITH WIC WARRANTS

PLEASE REMEMBER:



LARGEST SIZE, CHEAPEST BRAND AVAILABLE

Clients must purchase the largest size and cheapest brand available. Whenever two brands are the same price, the client may choose which brand to purchase.



FAT-FREE, 1%, 2% VS. WHOLE MILK WARRANTS

Please note that milk warrants specifically say which type of milk a client must buy. Only warrants that say “whole milk” can be used to buy whole milk, and only warrants that say “fat-free, 1%, 2%” can be used to buy fat-free, 1%, 2%, or buttermilk. This is based on children’s ages and nutritional needs, so it’s important that they buy the correct milk.

OTHER TYPES OF MILK

Lactose-free or Lactose-reduced Milk, UHT Milk, Soy Milk, Evaporated Milk, Dry Milk, and Goat’s Milk all have their own warrant types, and cannot be bought with a standard Fresh Milk warrant.

BUTTERMILK IS A LOW FAT MILK VARIETY.

Buttermilk can be purchased with fresh milk warrants for “fat-free, 1%, or 2%.” It cannot be purchased with fresh milk warrants for whole milk.
