- ❑ 2003 – CDC funds a planning grant for Alaska CCC
- ❑ State Cancer Plan 2006 - 2010
- ❑ 2007 – CDC funds an implementation grant
- ❑ State Cancer Plan 2011 - 2015
- ❑ 2012 – CDC funds 5 year grant
- ❑ State Cancer Plan 2016 - 2020
- ❑ 2017 – New grant cycle granted
