

# Training and Evaluation Plan: Request for Influenza Vaccine

## For State Certified EMT-2's and EMT-3's During the Division of Public Health Training, Drills, and During Public Health Emergencies

EMT-2	<p>Administration of Influenza Vaccine <b>ONLY</b> during State of Alaska, Division of Public Health training drills, exercises, and mass dispensing clinics AND/OR during a declared public health emergency.</p> <p><b>THIS DOES NOT AUTHORIZE EMT 2's/3's TO ROUTINELY ADMINISTER INFLUENZA VACCINE</b></p>	30 mins or longer	Demonstration of by each EMT-2 on administration of an IM injection with either influenza or saline under supervision of a person licensed or certified to administer influenza vaccine (e.g., Public Health Nurses, Physician Assistants and Physicians).
EMT-3	<p>Administration of Influenza Vaccine <b>ONLY</b> during State of Alaska, Division of Public Health training drills, exercises, and mass dispensing clinics AND/OR during a declared public health emergency.</p> <p><b>THIS DOES NOT AUTHORIZE EMT 2's/3's TO ROUTINELY ADMINISTER INFLUENZA VACCINE</b></p>	30 mins or longer	Demonstration of by each EMT-3 on administration of an IM injection with either influenza or saline under supervision of a person licensed or certified to administer influenza vaccine (e.g., Public Health Nurses, Physician Assistants and Physicians).

### FOR DRILLS and MASS DISPENSING CLINICS:

After this training has been completed, the person giving the training (often a PHN) will notify the Section of Injury Prevention and EMS, PRIOR to the start of the Mass Dispensing Clinic, that the training has been completed and submit a LEGIBLE list of the participants names (this can be faxed to 907.465.4101 or emailed to [lee.parham@alaska.gov](mailto:lee.parham@alaska.gov))

### DURING A PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY:

If the governor declares a condition of disaster (public health disaster) the State Medical Officer may open up mass vaccination clinics. If this occurs, a qualified person can administer the training to EMT-2's and EMT-3's and a LEGIBLE list of the participants' names must be submitted to the Section of Injury Prevention and EMS within 48 hours after the clinic opens.
