HOW TO REPORT A SUSPECTED FOODBORNE ILLNESS

Please contact your healthcare provider if you require medical assistance. This site is for reporting only, not for diagnosis or treatment.

To report to the Alaska Section of Epidemiology:

- *Send e-mail to:* InfDisease@alaska.gov. After your report is received, we will contact you by phone for an interview.

OR

- *Call the Section of Epidemiology* during business hours at: (907) 269-8000.

Please be prepared to provide us with the following information:

- Your symptoms
- The foods you had eaten within 7 days before illness
- Names and locations where the food was obtained and/or eaten
- Please note, your personal information will remain confidential
