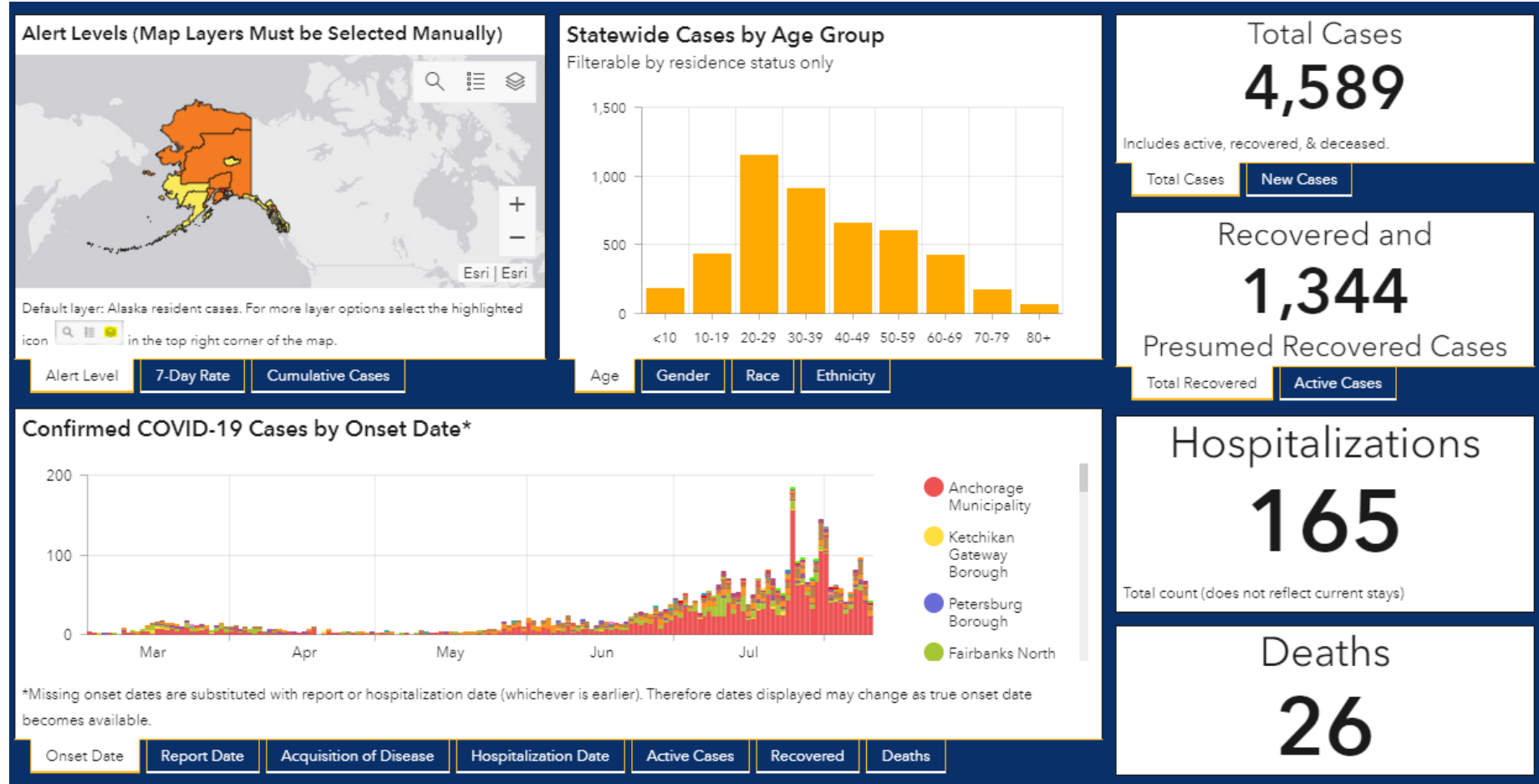

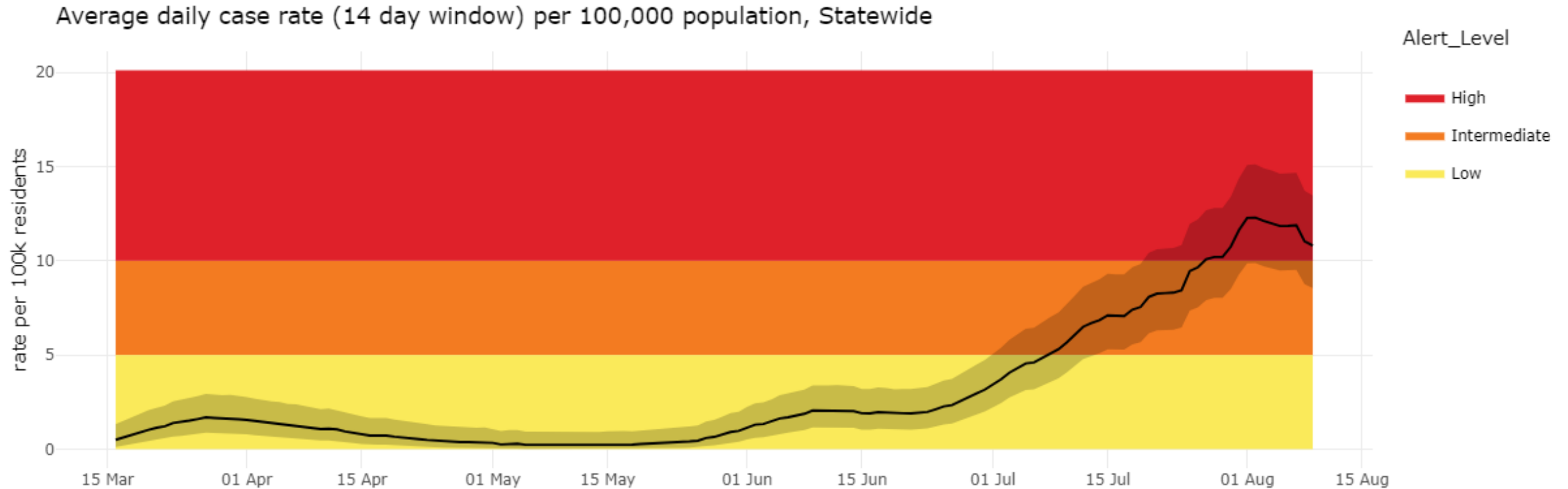


COVID-19 Dashboard: 8/11/20 reporting data from 8/10/20

- 45 new Alaska residents diagnosed with COVID-19 (3,851 total)
- 5 new nonresidents (768 total)
- 1,344 recovered cases
- No new deaths (26 total)
- 7 new hospitalizations (165 total)
- 290,744 cumulative tests
- 2.36% of tests were positive



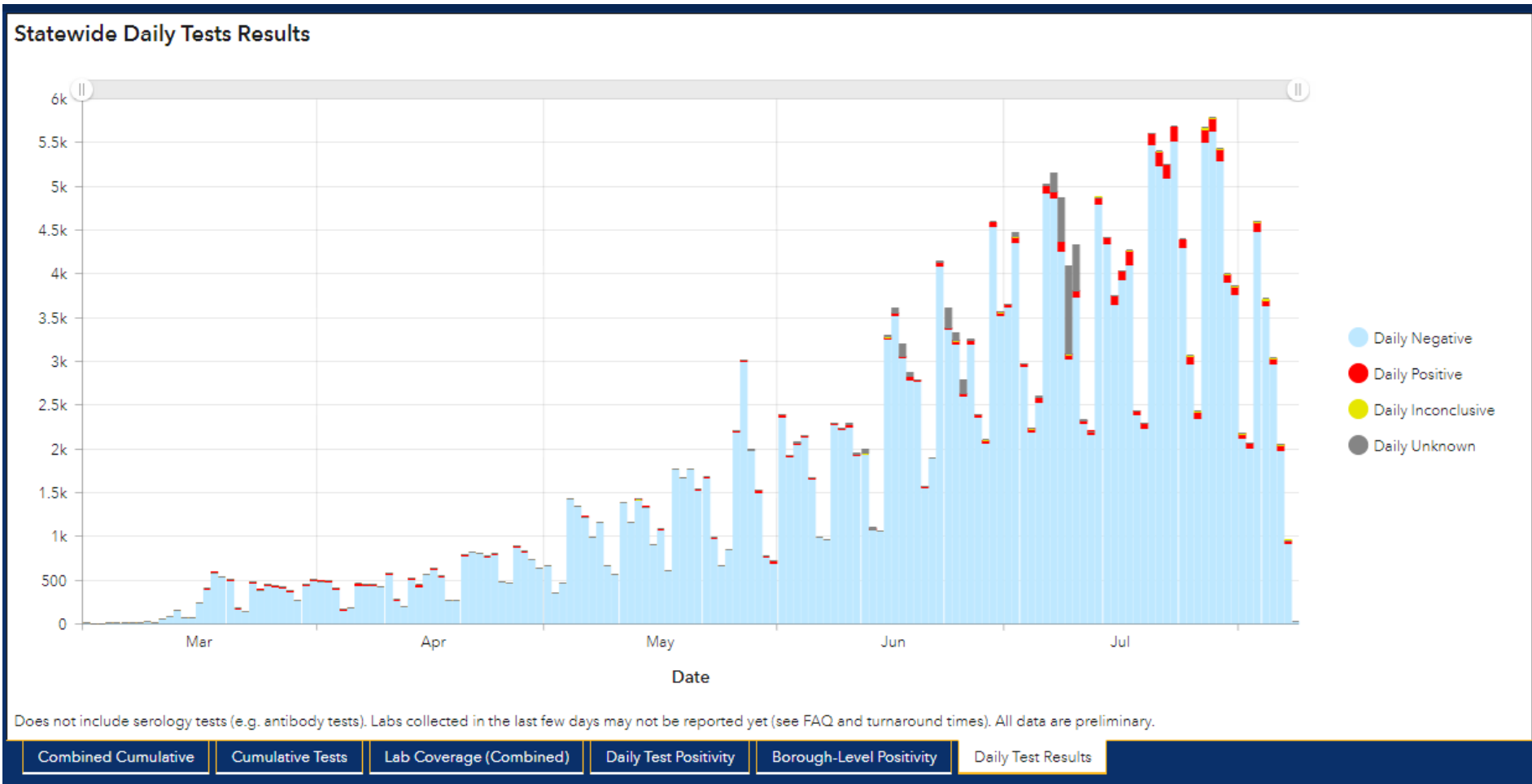
Average Daily Case Rate – Statewide



Current Alert Level: High

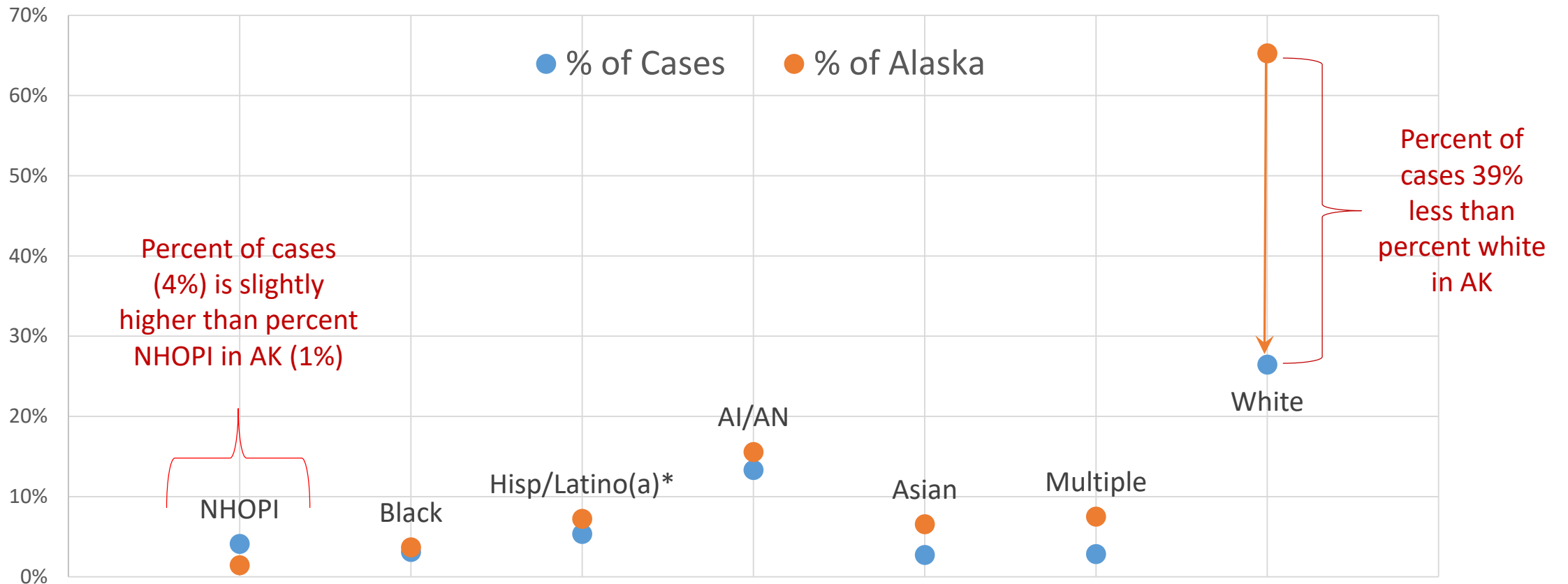

Changes to the Testing Dashboard



The Testing Dashboard was based on when the test result was returned to the state, but is now based on the date a test specimen was collected from an individual.

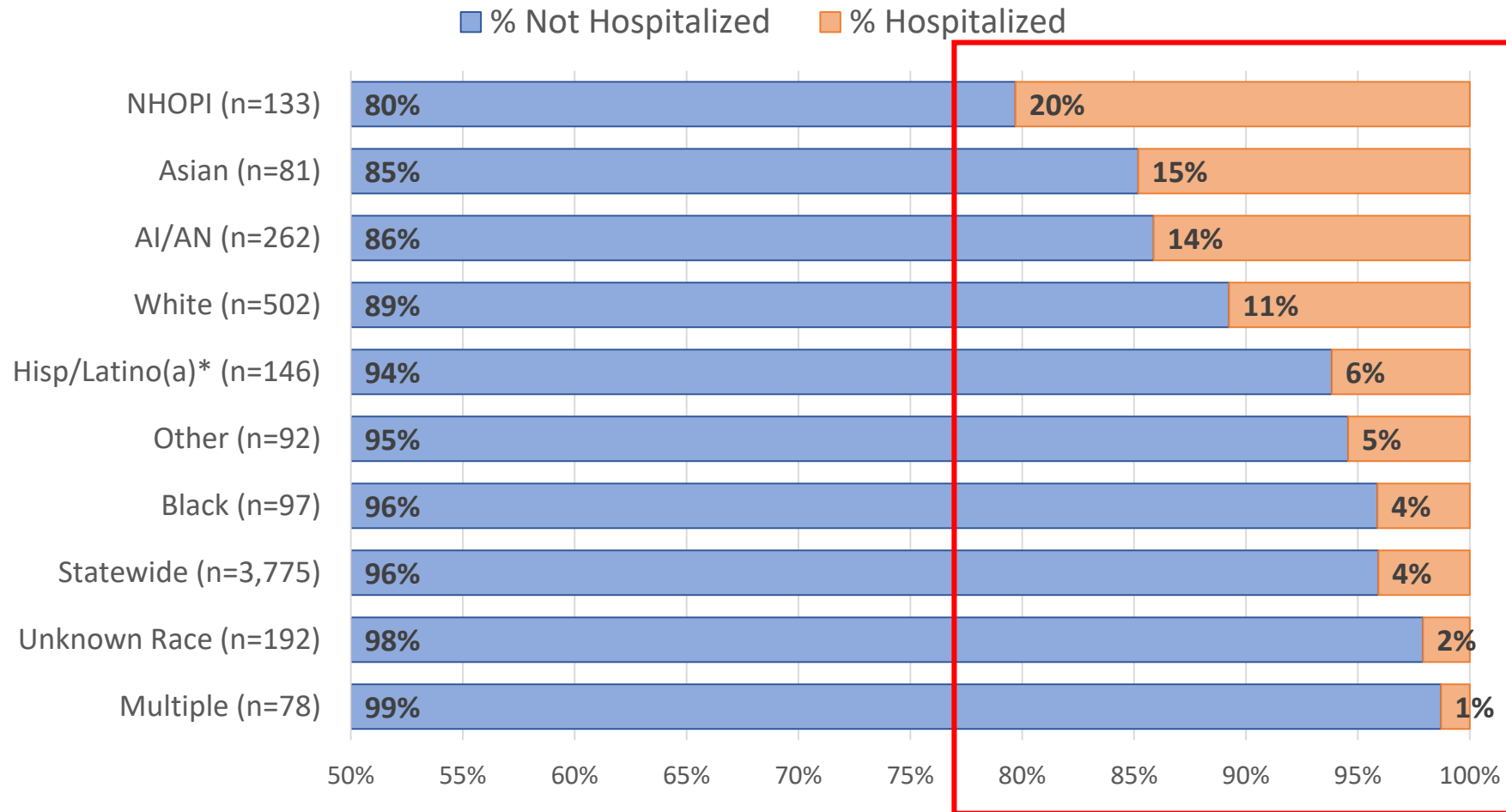
Does the distribution of cases reflect the population distribution?
