What is the administration fee for state-supplied vaccines?	<p>There is no change to the vaccine administration fee rules:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ For non-Medicaid VFC (Vaccine for Children) patients, the administration fee cap is \$27.44 ○ For Medicaid patients, the cap is the State Medicaid fee cap ○ For privately insured patients, the administration fee is your contracted vaccine administration fee
What eligibility status do I need to document?	<p>Document using the following eligibility codes:</p> <p>V02 = VFC Medicaid Eligible V03 = VFC Uninsured V04 = VFC American Indian/Alaska Native V05 = VFC Underinsured (FQHC) V06 = State Flu (2014-15 Season) V07 = State Vaccine (AVAP) V01 = Ineligible (Private Vaccine)</p> <p>Document funding source:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ “Public” – for all state-supplied vaccines ○ “Private” – for privately purchased vaccines

Who can receive state-supplied vaccines?	<p>All children can receive all state-supplied vaccines (see www.akvaccine.org/akvaccine.nsf/pages/for-providers.html), except flu in 2014-2015 season*, through:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ VFC: Medicaid, uninsured, American Indian/Alaska Native, and underinsured (FQHC) ○ AVAP: All other children

Which vaccines are included?	<p>Adult State Vaccine in 2015 include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ HPV (limited supply for females 19 through 26 yrs and males 19 through 21 yrs) ○ Meningococcal (limited supply for 19 through 20 yrs) ○ Pneumovax (PPSV23) ○ Td/Tdap ○ Zoster (ages 60 through 64 yrs) ○ Flu in 2015-16 season
Who can receive state-supplied vaccines?	<p>Providers <u>Opting-in</u> for uninsured adults can receive state vaccine for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ <u>All adults</u> <p>Providers <u>not</u> Opting-in can receive state-supplied vaccines for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Adults with a participating payer (a list of participating payers will be posted on www.akvaccine.org) ○ Medicaid-covered adults
What vaccines need to be privately purchased?	<p>Providers <u>Opting-in</u> for uninsured adults need to privately purchase for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ All non-state-supplied vaccines (i.e., Hep B, MMR, etc.) <p>Providers <u>not</u> Opting-in for uninsured adults need to privately purchase for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ All non-state-supplied vaccines (i.e., Hep B, MMR, etc.) ○ Adults with Medicare <u>only</u> ○ Adults with non-participating payers (a list of non-participating payers will be posted on www.akvaccine.org)

*State underinsured and insured children from 0 through 35 months will be covered by the State of Alaska.
