


Survey of healthcare providers who offer state-supplied vaccine within the Anchorage/Mat-su region impacted by the November 30, 2018 earthquake




DID YOU HAVE AN ALTERNATE POWER SOURCE THAT SUPPLIED POWER DURING THE OUTAGE?
