Influenza


- Out of stock
 - Sanofi Fluzone High Dose syringes for ages 65+ years
 - GSK Fluarix syringes for ages 6+ months
- Still available
 - Sanofi Fluzone multi-dose vials for ages 6+ months
 - Sanofi Fluzone syringes for ages 6-35 months

Grifols Td Vaccine is now called TDVAX (NDC and CVX codes remain the same)


GSK Bexsero 1pk is no longer offered on the CDC contract. Providers may to order the 1pk as long as it appears on the VacTrAK order set. Once the product is out of stock, it will be restricted from the order set and no longer available

Merck Pneumovax vials are no longer offered on the CDC contract. Providers may continue to order the vials as long as it appears on the VacTrAK order set. Starting in May, providers will order Pneumovax syringes instead




**Measles is just a plane trip away.
Vaccination is our best defense.**

Washington State, Oregon, Texas, New York and a growing number of states are experiencing measles outbreaks. So are many countries. Don't bring measles home with you!

BEFORE YOU TRAVEL

Talk to your health care provider and confirm your family's immunizations are up to date. MMR vaccine protects against measles. Children should get two doses of MMR, starting at 12-15 months with a second dose at 4-6 years of age.



AFTER YOU TRAVEL

Call your health care provider if you or anyone you have traveled with gets a fever and rash within three weeks of returning from your trip. Describe where you traveled.
