



If the McKesson shipment contained activated paper temperature indicators (warm or freeze)*



- 1) Store vaccines appropriately in storage unit and label "Do not use"
- 2) Do **not** receive or reject any doses from the pending order in VacTrAK
- 3) Call McKesson at the phone number on the temperature indicator **(1-877-836-7123)** the **same day** that you receive the shipment. *If you do not call the same day, you may not receive a reshipment.* Tell them:
 - o Facility information (PIN, Facility Name, State of Alaska, phone number)
 - o Delivery number from the packing slip
 - o Brief description of what happened (e.g. freeze indicator activated)
- 4) Email izcoldchain@cdc.gov and vaccinedepot@alaska.gov and include these attachments:
 - o **Packing slip** from inside the box that contained the activated temperature indicators (*see Example 1 to right*)
 - o **Picture** of the temperature indicators (*preferred, see Example 2 to right*) or a detailed description of what they looked like
 - o **This form**

- 5) Wait for further instructions from the Immunization Program. CDC will determine whether a reshipment is needed. You will electronically receive your order in VacTrAK once a reshipment arrives at your facility
- 6) Return to McKesson the doses deemed not viable by CDC. McKesson will mail or email you a UPS postage-paid address label

*These instructions apply to a shipment from McKesson only and do not apply to frozen vaccine shipments from Merck.

Vaccine Temperature Monitor

A TransTracker[®] C FREEZEmarker[®] Indicator is in this shipment to assure that your vaccines have been shipped under manufacturer-recommended conditions. The indicator shows temperature exposure only—not information about vaccine quality.

Accepting a Vaccine Shipment

- On arrival, remove the instruction card with the FREEZEmarker Indicator from the shipment box right away.
- Follow the guide on the back of this card to read the monitor.
- Examine the vaccines and shipping box for any signs of damage.
- **If you have any questions or concerns when reading the monitor, or if you see damage to the package, call 877-TEMP123 (877-836-7123) or your state/local immunization program right away.**
- Store vaccines as instructed below.

Vaccine Storage Requirements

- Take the vaccines out of the cooler and cardboard box immediately upon receipt.
- Refrigerate immediately at 35° to 46°F (2° to 8°C).
- Do not freeze or expose to freezing temperatures.

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
