



What's New in VacTrAK as of 4/12/2016

VacTrAK implemented a new version (5.16.1.2) on April 12, 2016 that includes some general bug fixes and the following updates:

1. Changes to Report Scheduling

Scheduled reports are now saved and accessed within VacTrAK after email notification of completion.

- Schedule reports is a user permission that can be added, contact VacTrAK Support for access.
- A new guide has been posted: [Schedule Reports Guide](#)
- Removes the risk of emailing protected health information and saves copies of reports within VacTrAK instead of email.

2. Patient Detail Report

- Added new functionality for filtering by "doses decremented from inventory."
- Added new functionality to export report as a .csv file.
- This report can be very helpful in researching inventory discrepancies.

3. Reminder Recall

- Issues with age range calculations and system time-outs when selecting a large number of patients have been resolved.
- New functionality has been added to schedule reminder recall.
- New functionality has been added to export patient list as a .csv file. Each vaccine for which the patient is due will list on a separate line for easy sorting and filtering of patient list.

4. Vaccine Order Receipt

Added new functionality to be able to receive individual vaccines in an order/transfer. Please contact the [Vaccine Depot](#) for assistance with vaccine inventory.

5. HL7 Message changes in PHC-Hub

Updated acknowledgment and query response HL7 message formatting to [CDC data exchange standards](#). *Major changes listed below, contact VacTrAK Support for details.*

- HL7 ACK Messages -Previously the value of MSH-9 did not accurately reflect the HL7 expected formatting in the response messages. Updated to the correct message type for acknowledgement messages.
- HL7 RESPONSE -Previously a v2.5.1 HL7 message that had multiple errors would display error information in the MSA segment and repeat MSA segment

segment and prevent repetition of the MSA segment.
