The development and continuing evolution of the Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Code Blue project involves a partnership between the Department, the Regional and sub-area Emergency Medical Services (EMS) offices, United States Department of Agricultural-Rural Development (USDA), local communities and others, such as the Alaska Council on Emergency Medical Services.

As part of their missions as grantees under the Emergency Medical Services program administered by the Department of Health and Social Services, the Regional EMS Offices routinely identify and prioritize rural EMS needs, including those for capital equipment and training. Several sources of funding have been identified for items within the Code Blue project, including local match, the United States Department of Agriculture-Rural Development(USDA), and the State of Alaska.

Nearly all of the items which are intended for purchase with State Code Blue funds have matching funds provided by the community and the USDA. However, there are a few communities with significant needs for essential EMS equipment who are not eligible for USDA funding. After careful consideration, we are proposing to allocate state funds to meet these needs. In such circumstances, local matching funds are being provided.
