# Review 5 Year Plan Goal


**Goal 8.1** Advocate for a minimum of 3 new or amended state or public programs, policies or practices each year that improve health and well-being



# Review 5-Year Plan Objectives

- **8.1.1** Continue to advocate for adequate services for individuals with autism
- **8.1.2** Develop recommendations for Medicaid reform using an ad hoc committee
- **8.1.3** Increase by 2% the number of individuals with disabilities who receive preventative health care
- **8.1.4** Increase by 5% the number of individuals experiencing disabilities who are prepared for a local or statewide disaster

# Review 5-Year Plan Objectives



- **8.1.6** Provide training for individuals with disabilities and their direct care professionals about receiving preventative health care
- **8.1.7** Provide training to individuals experiencing disabilities, their direct care professionals and emergency responders regarding emergency preparedness for individuals with disabilities
