

2014 Goals and Objectives from the GCDSE 5 Year Plan

TRANSPORTATION

Goal 4.1 Advocate for a minimum of 3 new or amended state or public programs, policies or practices per year that increase accessible public transportation options

4.1.1 Continue to support efforts to increase funding to develop public transportation infrastructure

- a) Educate legislators on the need for increased funding for infrastructure fund by 2011-2012
- b) Meet with local community leaders to educate them regarding the need for increased funding develop statewide public transportation infrastructure by 2012-2014

4.1.2 Advocate for the creation of a statewide public transportation board

- a) Make recommendations to the Governor's Coordinated Transportation Task Force by 2011-2012
- b) Identify legislator willing to introduce a bill to create a permanent community and public transportation advisory board by 2011-2012
- c) Educate legislators about bill to create public transportation board by 2011-2012
- d) Provide recommendations to the Governor on the selection of members for the board by 2012-2013

4.1.3 Advocate for transportation changes in Medicaid and waiver regulations/policies

- a) Provide public testimony on Home and Community Based waiver regulations changes affecting transportation by 2011-2012
- b) Provide recommendations for regulations changes to include transportation as part of supported employment services in the Home and Community Based waiver regulations by 2012-2014

4.1.4 Advocate with the Anchorage Assembly and community leaders for more accessible taxi service in Anchorage

- a) Meet with assembly members and Alaska Mobility Coalition members to develop strategy, conduct research, and engage by 2013-2014
- b) Provide letter of support for new ordinance and get advocates involved by 2013-2014
