


ROBERTS RULES OF ORDER

TO INTRODUCE BUSINESS

- You say: “I move to...”
- You may not interrupt
- The motion must be seconded
- It is debatable
- Majority vote to pass

TO AMEND A MOTION

- You say: “I move to amend this motion...”
- You may not interrupt
- Must be seconded, unless minor
- It is debatable
- Majority vote

TO CALL FOR A VOTE

- You say: “I move the previous question”
- You may not interrupt
- It must be seconded
- It is not debatable
- 2/3 majority vote

TO TABLE A MOTION FOR CONSIDERATION AT NEXT MEETING

- You say: “I move to table this motion”
- You may not interrupt
- It must be seconded
- It is not debatable
- Majority vote

TO SUSPEND THE RULES

- You say: “I move to suspend the rules and consider...”
- You may not interrupt
- It must be seconded
- It is not debatable
- 2/3 majority vote

TO ADJOURN THE MEETING

- You say: “I move that we adjourn”
- You may not interrupt
- It must be seconded
- It is not debatable
- Majority vote
