


Planning Process Summary:

- Comments from ACL incorporated
- Final plan version developed into public booklet

The State 5-Year Plan:

- **Illustrates the current Alaskan landscape**
 - In-depth narratives describe:
 - Health, Employment, informal and formal services and supports, Quality Assurance, Education and Early Intervention, Housing, Transportation, Childcare, Recreation, eligibility for services, barriers for unserved and underserved populations, assistive technology, waitlist process and data, adequacy of resources, DD network collaboration, etc.
 - Services, economy, unique barriers, rural nature, and other interrelated factors are explained throughout.
 - Extensive data collection on areas noted above
- **Describes Council structure**
- **Describes how stakeholder input was gathered**
- **Describes why goal areas were selected (i.e. logic model)**



State 5-Year Plan Goals
