

HELP FIGHT HOUSING DISCRIMINATION

The Fair Housing Enforcement Project of Alaska Legal Services Corporation is seeking individuals to assist in the investigation of illegal housing discrimination. **Fair Housing Testers** act as “secret shoppers,” posing as home seekers in a variety of housing/apartment rental situations. Testers are intermittent, as-needed employees – hours are flexible and vary. Hourly wage is \$20.00. Access to personal transportation is helpful, but not required. Excellent attention to detail is a must.

The Federal Fair Housing Act makes it illegal to discriminate in the rental, sale, financing, or insurance of housing based on race, color, national origin, sex, presence of children, and disability. Some local laws also prohibit discrimination based on marital status and age.

WHAT WE LOOK FOR IN TESTERS

- People of all ages above 18 of ANY race, color, national origin, religion, sex / gender identity, familial status, and disability status.
- People who are reliable, detail-oriented, and able to complete assignments on time.
- People who enjoy engaging in role play.
- People who can give a few hours during the day and/or evening, on weekdays, and/or weekends.
- People who have no prior felony convictions or convictions of crimes involving fraud or perjury, and who have no open cases with Alaska Legal Services.
- Individuals who have an active real estate license are not eligible.
