Description: Work Incentives offer an avenue for people receiving SSDI and SSI benefits a way of trying and succeeding at wage and self-employment. This training session will briefly review the work incentives connected to SSDI and SSI, and how they promote work.

SSDI:

- 9 month trial work period
- Impairment Related Work Expenses
- Expedited Reinstatement of Benefits
- Subsidies

SSI:

- PASS Plans
- Student Earned Income Exclusion
- Property Essential Self-Support
