4. RCCY Program Updates – Deb Craig

- A. Issues Clarification
- TB tests are NOT currently required.
 - Issues Clarification – Regulations specifically state that a “residential care provider shall ensure that each caregiver, other than a volunteer, receives a minimum of 15 hours of training per year” – this has been interpreted to be during each state fiscal year for OCS and from date of hire by licensing. DHSS will work on consistency in this issue.
- B. Placement Discussion - participants essentially recognized that this may be more of an issue for Level II’s and Deb will submit a draft of desired information to all Level II providers for input and then submit the request to the Chief of Field Services (OCS). Our goal is to have a consistent policy of information dissemination across the state. Items noted during and after the meeting that are desired at time of placement from OCS:
- Medications/medical needs
 - Psychiatric evaluations or other assessments within the last 6 months
 - Behavioral concerns
 - Academic Concerns and Information
 - Appropriate and desired interactions with parents or other guardians
