Priority 2: Expanding and improving access to a mixed delivery system of federal, state, local and non-governmental early learning programs Priority 3: Maintain clear, cohesive statewide expectations, tied to data driven outcome measures for young children and students in K-12 school. Priority 4: Engage stakeholders to increase knowledge and public awareness in the early learning community through a strong and cohesive Alaska Early Childhood Coordinating Council.
