# Alleged Victims Reported

Unique count of children who were alleged victims in a child protective services report received during the year.



From 2009-2011, the increase in alleged victims is influenced by a policy change. In February 2010, OCS began entering all reports to OCS as protective service reports. Prior to this policy change, only children in reports with allegations that met the definition of child maltreatment were counted as alleged victims. After this change, children in all reports are included in the counts of alleged victims.





Unique count of children who were alleged victims in a child protective services report screened-in during the year.









## Substantiated Allegations by Maltreatment Type and Victim's Race







Unique count of children who had a substantiated allegation in an initial assessment that was closed during the year and who were removed from home within 12 months before or after the date of the screening decision.



## Substantiated Victims Removed by Region













These National Rankings show your State's performance on the Composites compared to the performance of all the other States that were included in the 2004 data. For example, "1 of 47" would indicate this State performed higher than all the States in 2004.






