

Alaska Office of Children's Services - Statistics for the Month of September 2020

This page includes statistics divided into the following four categories:

Protective Service Reports

1,556 Protective Service Reports were screened:

- 604 were screened in,
- 952 were screened out.

Initial Assessments

579 Initial Assessments were completed:

- 154 were Substantiated,
- 405 were Not Substantiated,
- 25 were Closed Without a Finding.

Out-of-Home Care

Please note that due to administrative processing, there may be a significant lag for entry of discharge data into ORCA, which may affect reporting accuracy for recent periods.

3,145 children were in an Out-of-Home care (2,043 of these were Alaskan Native/American Indian):

- 106 children were removed from their home (65 of these were AN/AI),
- 68 children were discharged from Out-of-Home care (38 of these were AN/AI).

Licensed Providers. ICWA homes meet the standard for the Indian Child Welfare Act.

1,649 total Licensed Providers were made up of the following types:

- 743 Non-Child-Specific Foster Homes (160 of which were ICWA),
- 626 Child-Specific Foster Homes,
- 160 Non-Child-Specific Foster Group Homes (22 of which were ICWA),
- 48 Child-Specific Foster Group Homes,
- 21 Child Placement Agencies,
- 34 Residential Child Care Facilities,
- 13 Residential Psychiatric Treatment Centers,
- 3 Maternity Homes,
- 1 Tribal Foster Homes,
- 0 Independent Living Programs,
- 0 Assisted Living Facilities.
