

Alaska Office of Children's Services - Statistics for the Month of January 2021

This page includes statistics divided into the following four categories:

Protective Service Reports

1,449 Protective Service Reports were screened:

- 628 were screened in,
- 821 were screened out.

Initial Assessments

386 Initial Assessments were completed:

- 122 were Substantiated,
- 247 were Not Substantiated,
- 20 were Closed Without a Finding.

Out-of-Home Care

Please note that due to administrative processing, there may be a significant lag for entry of discharge data into ORCA, which may affect reporting accuracy for recent periods.

3,131 children were in an Out-of-Home care (2,046 of these were Alaskan Native/American Indian):

- 115 children were removed from their home (81 of these were AN/AI),
- 80 children were discharged from Out-of-Home care (45 of these were AN/AI).

Licensed Providers. ICWA homes meet the standard for the Indian Child Welfare Act.

1,597 total Licensed Providers were made up of the following types:

- 726 Non-Child-Specific Foster Homes (141 of which were ICWA),
- 608 Child-Specific Foster Homes,
- 155 Non-Child-Specific Foster Group Homes (20 of which were ICWA),
- 37 Child-Specific Foster Group Homes,
- 20 Child Placement Agencies,
- 38 Residential Child Care Facilities,
- 9 Residential Psychiatric Treatment Centers,
- 2 Maternity Homes,
- 2 Tribal Foster Homes,
- 0 Independent Living Programs,
- 0 Assisted Living Facilities.
