HB96 "Pioneers' Home and Veterans' Home Rates" Becomes Law

On April 29, 2020, Governor Dunleavy signed into law House Bill 96 "Pioneers' Home and Veterans' Home Rate." In summary, Pioneer Home rates are now set by law at a decreased monthly rate for each level of care, along with amending several other elements of the division's operational framework. The amendments are as follows:

- Pioneer Home monthly rates are set in state law (not in Department of Health & Social Services' regulation) at the following prices:
 - Level I \$2,976
 - Level II \$5,396
 - Level III \$7,814
 - Level IV \$9,333
 - Level V rate determined by the department that sufficiently compensates the state for the care and support of these residents
- Resident's income threshold is increased to \$300 per month.
- Payment assistance income threshold is increased to \$300 per month.
- The minimum age for waitlist eligibility is lowered to 60 years old.

Implementation of HB96 changes will go into effect July 1, 2020.

The Alaska Pioneer Home website and applicable publications will be updated to reflect the above changes upon the July 1, 2020 effective date.
