

BOOST YOUR PROTECTION

Everyone 12+ should get a free COVID-19 vaccine booster when it's time.

Who is eligible	Anyone 12 years or older who has completed the two-dose series	Anyone 18 years or older who has completed the two-dose series	Anyone 18 years or older who has received a single dose

Why get a booster?

COVID-19 vaccines are working well to prevent hospitalizations and deaths from severe COVID-19. But over time, public health experts have seen reduced protection. A booster makes that protection stronger and longer-lasting.

Which booster is right for me?

While all authorized COVID-19 vaccines are safe and effective at reducing your risk of severe illness, the Moderna and Pfizer vaccines are preferred by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).

How do I get a booster?

COVID-19 vaccine boosters are available at most pharmacies and provider offices in Alaska.
