Dear Tribal Health Leader,

On behalf of the Department of Health and Social Services (DHSS), I am writing to inform you of a proposed future Medicaid state plan amendment (SPA), in keeping with DHSS's responsibility to conduct tribal consultation.

Excluded Drugs for Dual Eligible Recipients: The Department intends to submit a SPA that would modify the current coverage of previously excluded outpatient drugs for recipients with both Medicaid and Medicare coverage ("dual eligible"). As of January 1, 2014, barbiturates will no longer be excluded from coverage by the Medicare part D prescription drug plans and coverage for these medications for dual eligible recipients will fall under the recipient's Medicare PDP. Barbiturates had previously been covered by Alaska Medicaid for dual eligible recipients if they were used for something other than the treatment of epilepsy, cancer, or a chronic mental health disorder because these drug classes were previously excluded from coverage by the Medicare PDPs. While access to these medications is not anticipated to be impacted because coverage will continue under the recipient's Medicare prescription drug plans there may be an impact to tribal recipients and providers due to this change.
