Dear Tribal Health Leader,

On behalf of the Department of Health and Social Services (DHSS), in keeping with the DHSS responsibility to conduct tribal consultation, this letter is written to confirm the submission of a Medicaid State Plan Amendment (SPA) as agreed upon during the consultative process begun during collaborative meetings between the Alaska Native Health Board, Alaska Tribal Health Systems, and the State of Alaska the week of May 2-5, 2016, and June 13-14, 2016.

Changes to Transportation Benefit to clarify the arrangement of transportation services: the filed amendment provides clarification within the State Plan regarding the arrangement of transportation services by a broker and the arrangement of transportation services by a government entity. Specifically, the amendment establishes clarification regarding the ability of a government entity to provide transportation administration services and defining transportation as an optional medical service.
