Tribal Consultation Letter

On behalf of the Department of Health and Social Services (the department), and in keeping with the responsibility to conduct tribal consultation, I am writing to inform you of the opportunity for consultation regarding a proposed-future Medicaid state plan amendment (SPA). *The department offers this opportunity in conjunction with public notice for a regulation change.*

Changes to eligible behavioral health providers and reimbursement requirements – The department intends the proposed state plan amendment to update the relevant provider, service, and reimbursement sections described in attachment 3.1-A and attachment 4.19-B of the Alaska Medicaid state plan, to reflect:

- the addition of licensed clinical social workers as Medicaid billing providers;
- expansion of services for which psychologists may receive Medicaid reimbursement;
- the addition of Screening, Brief Intervention, and Referral to Treatment (SBIRT) service description and reimbursement language; and
- a revision of existing screening services and reimbursement language in accordance with the behavioral health system redesign.

The state anticipates the proposed changes to the Medicaid state plan will increase access to appropriate and timely services for all Alaskans, including American Indian and Alaska Native beneficiaries.

Tribal health clinics may benefit from the expanded scope of psychological services eligible for reimbursement.

Written comments regarding the proposed state plan amendment are due on July 29, 2019, by 4:30 PM. The department must receive any requests for an in-person meeting regarding the proposed amendment within 15-days of the date on this letter.
